If this form is not so deposited, it may, however, be handed to the Chairman of the Court Meeting at the Court Meeting prior to the relevant vote, who shall have absolute discretion as to whether or not to accept it.
- A proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the Court Meeting in person to represent you.
